What does this look like in a community:

Some Commonly Asked Questions on this tax credit:

What is the Working Poor Tax Credit? When you donate to a qualified non-profit, like Arizona Neighborhood Transformation, you can reduce what you owe n Arizona State Tax by \$400 (married couple) or \$200 (single filers).

Does this tax credit also apply to Federal Returns? No – this is only for Arizona State tax. You may also be able to claim a federal deduction for the amount donated, but you will need to check with your tax professional

How do I take advantage of this? If interested, you can give a donation to a qualified non-profit this year (by year end). Then you can take off the appropriate amount (\$400 for married and \$200 for single) on the Arizona Income Tax return for the year of the donations. Please see your tax professional for the proper way to record the deduction on your income tax. The non-profit (like AZNT) will provide a receipt to use with your income tax
